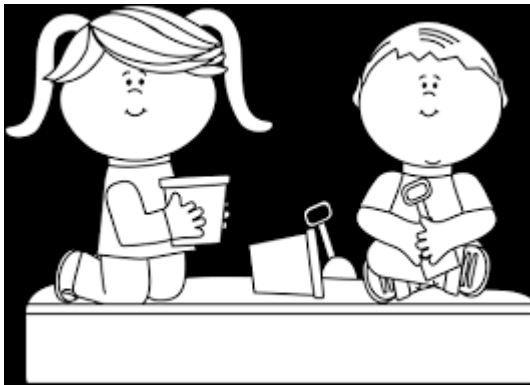

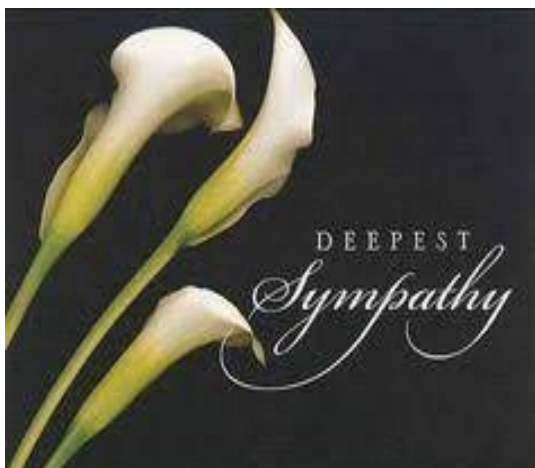
In Loving Memory

PENTECOST SYMBOLS

There are many ways in which we can remember that we are Pentecost people in this world. Here are some of the Bible's reminder:



THE SIGN OF THE DOVE

And just as he was coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens torn apart and the Spirit descending like a dove upon him. **MARK 1:10**

At the baptism of Jesus, the Holy Spirit descended as a dove upon him, and we who have been baptized into Christ are blessed by the sight of doves from time to time to remind us that the Spirit has landed upon us as well.



TONGUES OF FIRE

Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. **ACTS 2:3**

The tongues of fire that appeared over the heads of the disciples at Pentecost revealed their burning desire to share Jesus. When we see a campfire or candle burning, we remember that the Spirit's fire is in us, too, to share.



A MIGHTY WIND

And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. **ACTS 2:2**

Wind rushed through the room on Pentecost to move the people to act. When the wind pushes us along on a blustery day, we are reminded that the Holy Spirit continues to move us forward in our faith.
