THE FOLLOWING STUDENTS WILL BE GRADUATING THIS YEAR:

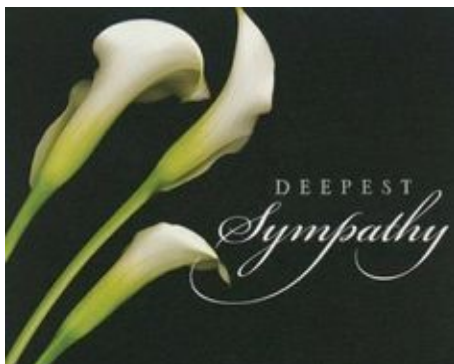


