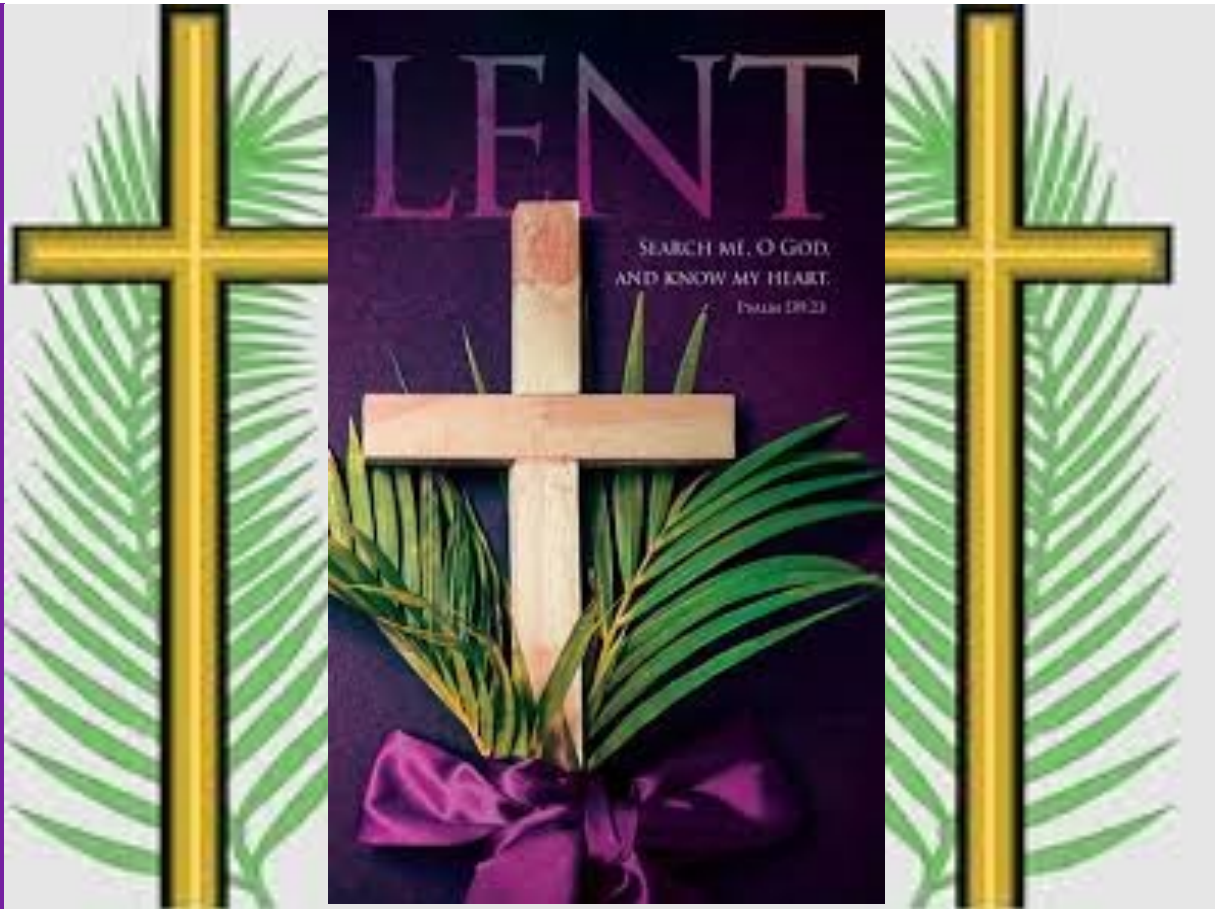

## **SESSION UPDATE**

- Session approved a motion to close the Church if Belmont County is at a Level 2 snow emergency or higher. Hopefully, this will improve communication and allow members and staff to plan appropriately.
- Copies of the Proposed General Assembly Amendments (58 pages) have been placed in the library for your review. The time schedule for approval by the Upper Ohio Valley Presbytery is included. It is important that members become familiar with what PCUSA is recommending at a national level, as it will impact current policy of this church. There is a Round Table discussion scheduled at the UOVP on Thursday March 20 from 5:30-7:30.
- The Fulcrum Center programming has two more seminars coming up: **What's My Identity** on March 8 and **What's My Purpose** on March 22. These are in Fellowship Hall from 8:30 until noon.
- Looking Ahead:

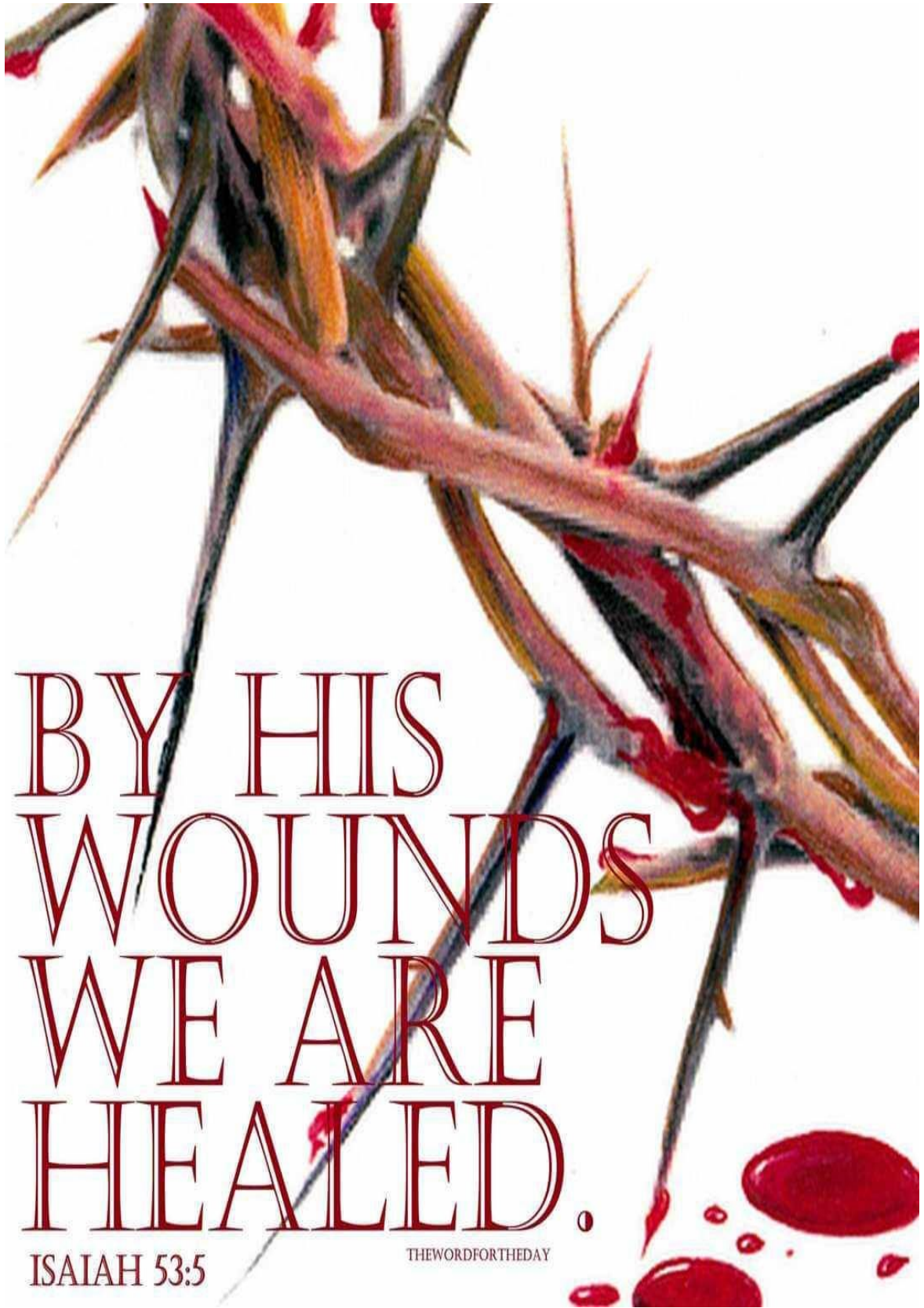
